PAYMENT

Payment Method = Internet Bank Transfer

Details will be emailed after you've registered online.

Note: Other payment options* are by arrangement only and must be deposited by you into the MYC account before the relevant cut-off date. * Cash or Cheques (payable to 'Christian Student Support')

THE FINE PRINT (in largish letters!)

Discount Rates: We must have received full payment by the relevant cut-off date for you to receive any discounted rate. Registering online doesn't count!

Late Payment: Unless a prior arrangement has been made with the MYC Coordinator (Steve McKerney), if you have not paid **in full** by July 10th we will assume that you are not coming. No MYC for you!

Withdrawal: If you pull out of MYC after July 10th —for whatever reason—we will refund any fees paid **minus \$100**. This is necessary to cover our costs already incurred, such as Caterer charges, food costs, MYC Booklet, etc.

Last-minute rate \$250 (July 4th to July 10th)

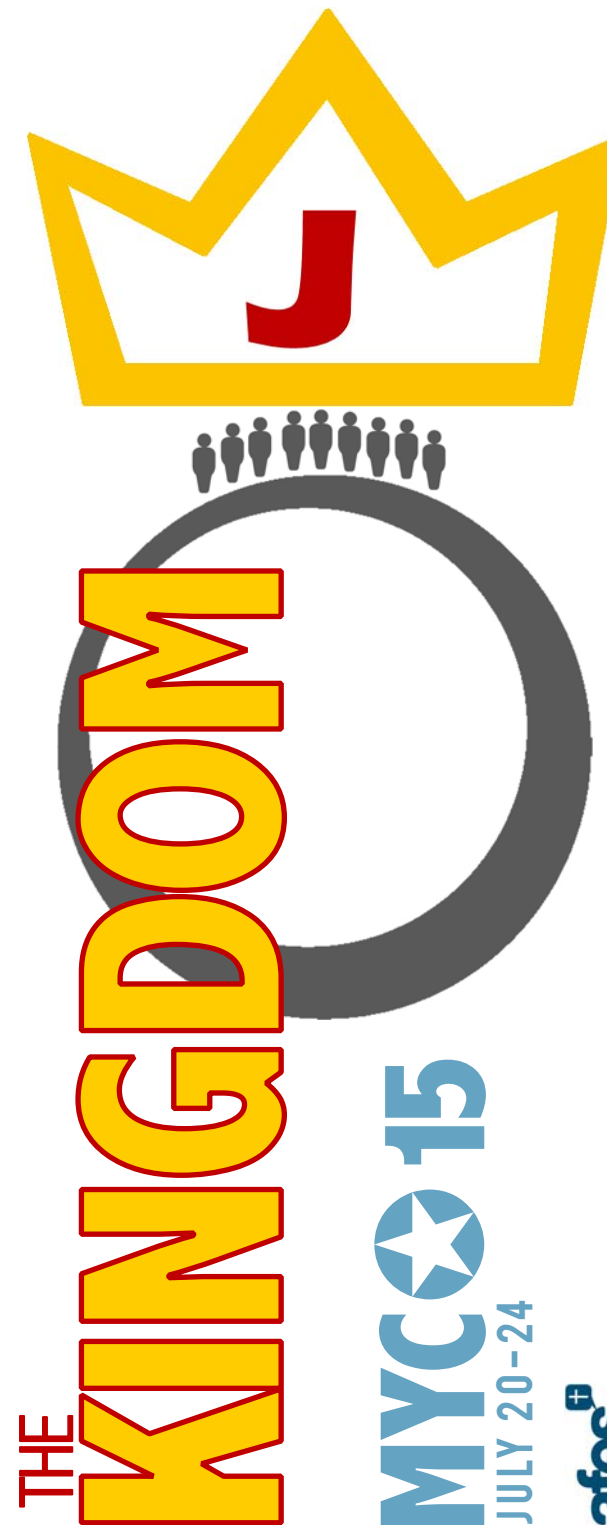
